Dear customers,

The European directive called RoHS (2002/95/CE, modified in directive 2011/65/EU of June 8th, 2011 - limitation of the use of certain dangerous substances) concerns the limitation of the concentration of certain dangerous substances in the electric and electronic equipment, at levels defined in the above-named directive.

The acceptable maximal concentrations by mass of material are fixed to 0.1 % for the lead, the mercury, the hexavalent chromium, the polybromobiphényles ( PBB), the polybromodiphényléthers ( PBDE) and 0.01 % for the cadmium.

These maximal values are imposed to guarantee the protection of the human beings and the environment by choosing safer products, allowing a better collection at the end of life as well as a better traceability of those products and a more appropriate treatment.

As regard for the products which are supplied in your company (stainless steel tubes), La MEUSIENNE declares by the present document that all the products made and marketed since the publication of the directive RoHS are in accordance with the constraints of this one (respect for the limits in concentration such as described above in this document).

We naturally remain at your disposal for any question relating to the safety of our products.
